GLOSSARY OF TYPES OF FUNERAL SERVICES

BURIAL

Complete Funeral Service

Family and friends are invited to visit the funeral home to pay their respects to the deceased and offer condolences to the family. Visitation provides time for sharing and remembrance and is followed by a funeral ceremony at a place of worship or in our chapel. Following the funeral ceremony, the deceased is transported to the cemetery where he/she is placed in their final resting place.

Graveside Service

Family and friends are invited to visit the funeral home to pay their respects to the deceased and offer condolences to the family. Visitation provides time for sharing and remembrance and is followed by a funeral ceremony at the cemetery.

Memorial Service

Family and friends are invited to a ceremony for sharing and remembrance of the deceased at a time either before or after the deceased has been placed in their final resting place. Free from the presence of a casket, a chapel or an alternative site can be arranged with photographs and personal items from the home.

CREMATION

Complete Funeral Service

Family and friends are invited to visit the funeral home to pay their respects to the deceased and offer condolences to the family. Visitation provides time for sharing and remembrance and is followed by a funeral ceremony at a place of worship or in our chapel. Following the funeral ceremony, the deceased is transported to the crematorium for cremation. Following the cremation, arrangements are made with the family for the return of cremated remains and/or a committal service is scheduled for the placement of the deceased in the final resting place.

Memorial Service

Family and friends are invited to a ceremony for sharing and remembrance of the deceased at a time either before or after the deceased has been placed in their final resting place. A chapel or an alternative site can be arranged with photographs and personal items from the home.

Credit Policy

It is our purpose to provide quality service and merchandise to those families that we serve and to be fair in conducting all business transactions. The following credit guidelines have been established in order that there be no misunderstandings. If you or your family have a special need or situation, please let us know in advance and we will be glad to discuss alternative arrangements.

- 1. Acceptable payment methods are: Cash, Check, Money Order, Insurance Assignment, Credit Card, or a combination of these methods.** An insurance assignment will be acceptable only upon verification that the insurance policy or policies are in force and must be signed by the listed beneficiary or beneficiaries.
- 2. Stanley Funeral Home and Crematory uses Cincinnati Equitable Life Insurance Company a third party company to pay all insurance claims.** There will be a charge of 3% of the total funeral bill added to the funeral bill to collect the terms of the contract. Cincinnati Equitable Life Insurance will file your families insurance and pay the funeral home within 24 Hours.
- 3. Any account showing a balance after 30 days from the date of the contract and in which there are no assigned insurance funds pending will be considered past due.**
- 4. Each past due account will begin accruing interest on the thirty first (31st) day past the date of the contract.** Interest will accrue at the rate of one and one half percent (1.5%) per month, eighteen percent (18%) annually, on the unpaid balance.
- 5. Credit Card:** There will be a 3.5% Processing fee for using a credit card. There is no fee for using a debit card.

If you have a special situation or a financial hardship, please discuss this with the funeral director so that alternative arrangements may be made prior to the arrangement conference.
If you wish to avoid interest and/ or know that you cannot make full payment within thirty (30) days, it is recommended that an alternative financing source such as a bank or credit union be

considered so that a loan may be obtained and monthly payments may be made to that Financial Institution.

BASIC SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR, STAFF, AND OVERHEAD

This fee represents a proportionate share of our operating costs necessary to provide our Customers with the best facilities and services we can offer. It is made up of two Components: services of funeral director and staff; basic overhead.

Our services include: **\$ 2,295**

- Conducting the arrangement conference;
- Planning the funeral;
- Consulting with family and clergy;
- Obtaining necessary permits and authorizations;
- Coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties.

This fee for our basic services of funeral director, staff, and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements regardless of the package you select.

TRANSPORTATION

- Removal and transfer to the funeral home \$ 350

EMBALMING (includes dressing, casketing and cosmetology) \$ 1,050

Embalming is a chemical process that provides temporary preservation of the body and eliminates certain health hazards. Sanitary preparation of the deceased is part of the Embalming process. This procedure must be completed by a funeral professional licensed by the state.

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be Necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with visitation. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or immediate burial.

CREMATION \$ 750

The casket or cremation container is placed in a cremation chamber at our funeral home which is heated to an extremely high temperature. The intense heat reduces the casket or cremation container, as well as the remains, to small bone fragments which are then placed in a processor and reduced in size. The cremated remains are then placed in an urn or temporary container and returned to the family.

The purpose of the outer burial container is to protect your loved one from cemetery maintenance equipment and environmental elements. Not all containers provide the same level of protection so we are pleased to offer several different types for you to choose from. Our funeral director will be happy to explain the options to you. In most areas of the country, state, or local law does not require that you purchase a container to surround the casket in the grave. However, many cemeteries require that you have such a container so the grave will not sink in. Either a grave liner or burial vault will satisfy these requirements

The purpose of the cremation urn is to provide a container for the cremated remains of your loved one. Urns may then be used to support your choice for final resting place, whether it be in the cemetery in a columbarium niche, ground burial, in an urn garden, or in your home. - There are usually three costs associated with the cemetery – opening and closing the grave, cemetery upkeep fund, and any unpaid balance for space (cemetery plot or mausoleum space) that had been purchased in advance on a payment plan. Costs associated with the crematory are for the cremation process. Payment in full is required for these prior to receiving the deceased for burial, cremation and interment / entombment. As part our service we include these charges on the statement of goods and services that will be explained to you following your selections. We make arrangements for opening/closing the grave on for vaults purchased from us.
